Throughout the academic year, TSLG members have the unique privilege of engaging with influential leaders, including Members of Parliament and representatives from The Diana Award, Google, Rotary International, and the Bank of England. TSLG students also have the privilege of hosting various distinguished visitors, enriching their educational experience.

We proudly celebrate the significant accomplishment of the 2023 TSLG cohort, who have successfully completed the SSAT Leadership accreditation, which encompasses both primary and secondary students and showcases their unwavering commitment to personal growth and development. The accreditation includes ten essential skill strands which are developed throughout the course.

Members of the Trust Student Leadership Group are given substantial responsibilities during their year as leaders. The journey begins with a rigorous selection process, where they write persuasive application letters. Once selected, they are tasked with exceeding academy attendance targets, achieving year-end progress milestones, and exemplifying positive ambassadors for their academy's Behaviour Policy. Additionally, they embrace the role of mentors, providing guidance and support to their peers.
